

## WATER AND SEWER DEFERRED PAYMENT AGREEMENT

Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 185.38 requires water utilities to offer deferred payment agreements (DPAs) to residential customers who are unable to pay their bill in full. A DPA consists of two elements; a reasonable down payment and an installment plan to pay the remaining outstanding balance over a specified period of time. A customer with a DPA is required to pay his or her current charges in full in addition to the agreed upon installment payment. The utility must receive each payment on or before the due date. A late or missed payment will cause the DPA to "default" and place the customer in jeopardy of disconnection. Delinquent amounts paid according to the terms of an established DPA are not subject to late charges.
